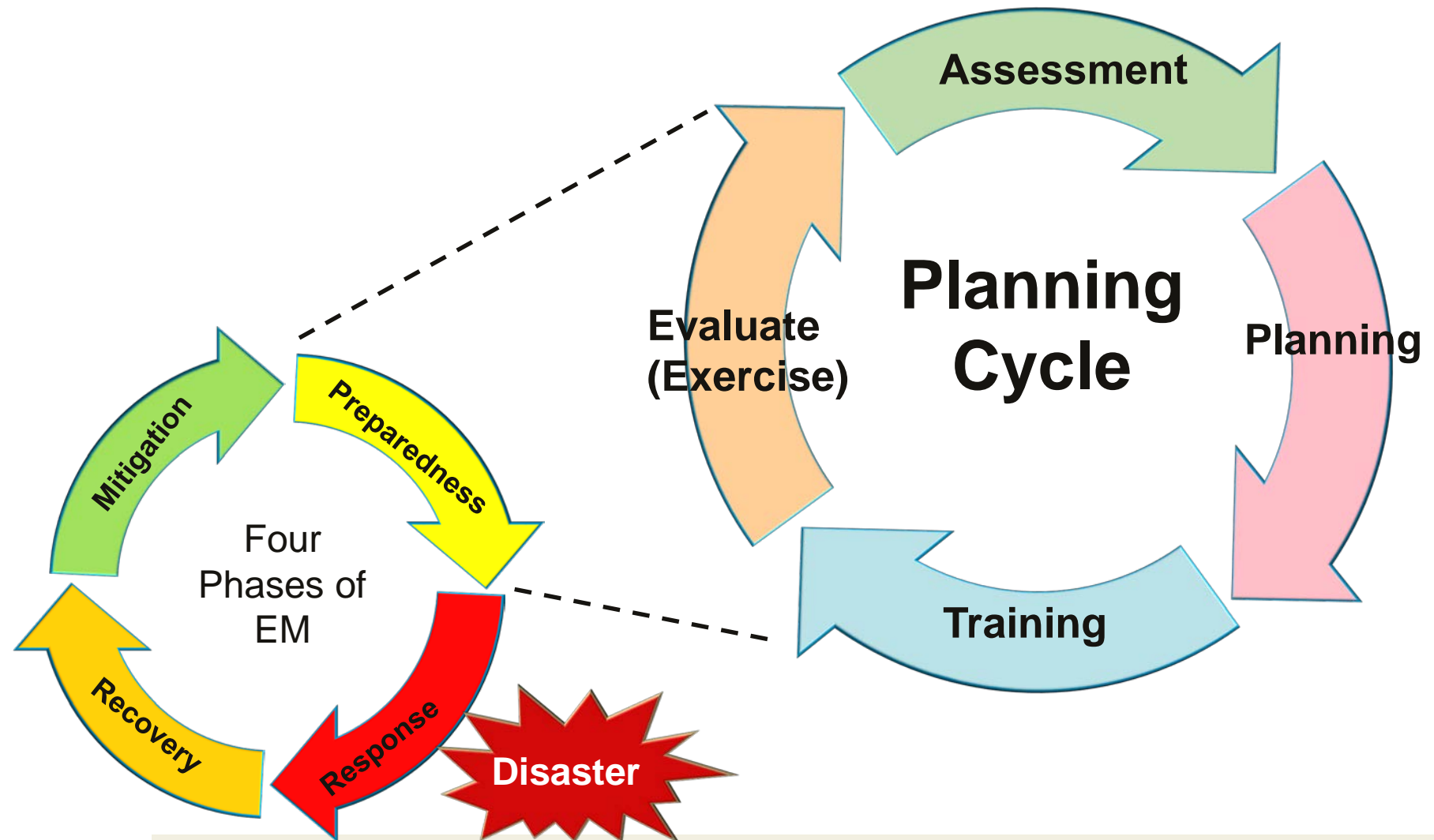
Local EM Perspective

Opportunity for Mutual Aid (Non-Disaster)



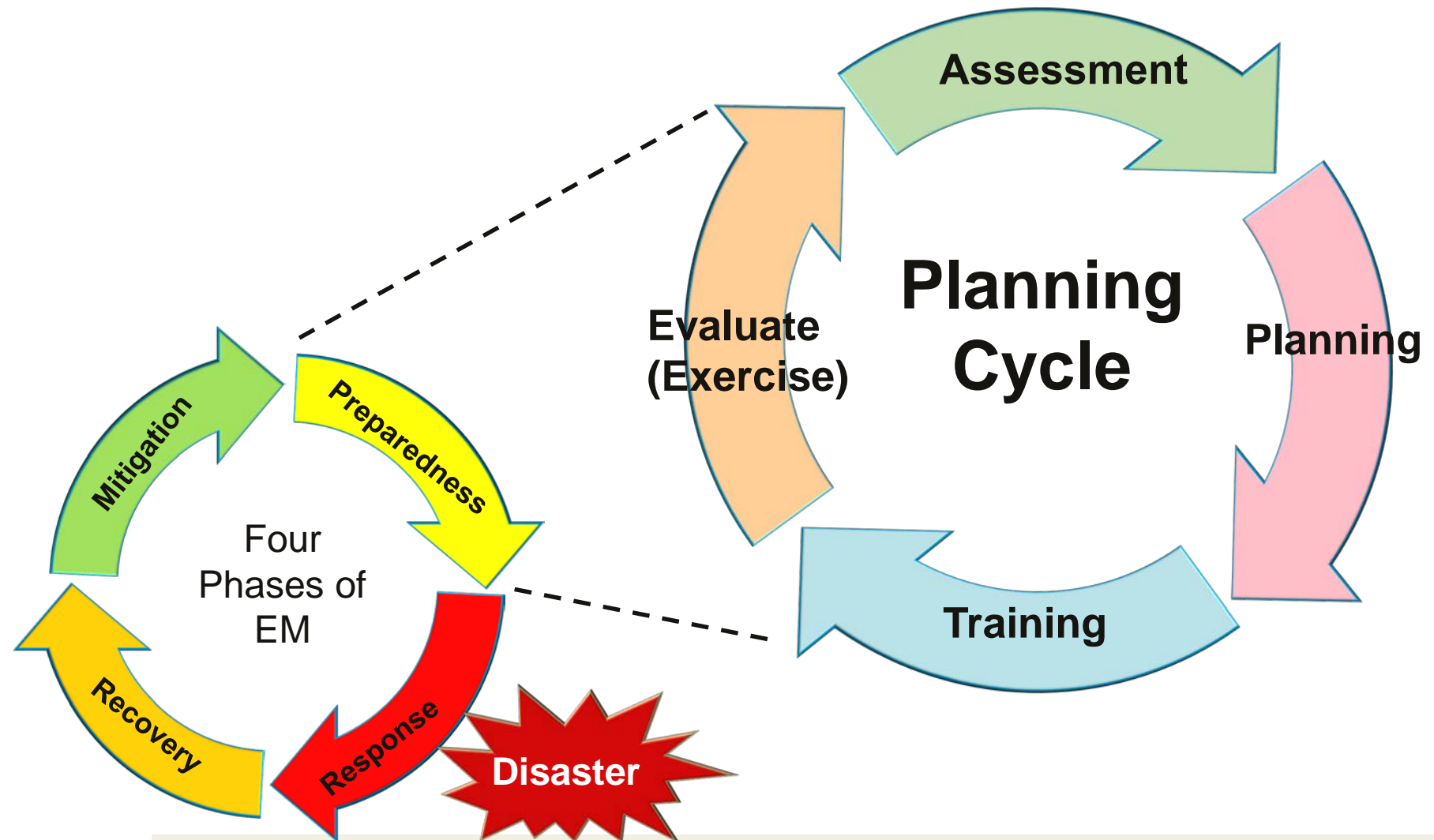
Mutual Aid

Mutual aid agreements establish the terms under which one party provides resources— personnel, teams, facilities, equipment, and supplies—to another party. Because most jurisdictions do not maintain sufficient resource levels to handle events independently, mutual aid agreements provide a means for jurisdictions to augment their resources when needed ... **BOTH IN TIMES OF NORMALCY AND DISASTER!**
